

COVID-19 Highfield Golf Management Plan - Level 2

COVID-19 is a virus that primarily spreads via respiratory droplets and contact with infected surfaces. Symptoms can include a high fever, coughing and difficulty breathing amongst others.

Playing of golf does present a risk of transmission.

The most important principle is to stay safe and to stay physically distant from others.

Golf can be played at Alert Level 2. **If you decide to play golf, you must do so under the following guidelines:**

1. You must take all the necessary hygiene measures and stay safe
2. **Please fill in the register before and after you finish.** You must use your own pen and sanitise after
3. Physical distancing between staff, players and visitors should be maintained where possible, at least one metre but two metres is encouraged
4. If you use the Town and Country Club facilities, their guidelines must be followed
5. All players should wash or sanitise hands after play
6. The course toilet is closed
7. Club competitions can be held as long as there is strict adherence to hygiene and distancing
8. Scorecards can be used, exchanging of cards should not occur
9. Ensure distancing between groups is maintained. Allow 10 minutes between groups
10. Flagsticks can be left on the greens but should be left in the holes.
11. Your ball can be played from the bunkers if the match committee allow this. Rakes will be put out on the course. Players do have the right to not touch the rakes
